

- Off leash area will be open from sunrise to sunset seven days a week unless closed for maintenance.
- Dog must be current on all shots, dog license and have a City of Kalamazoo dog park pass purchased at the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the park.
- Owners are responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them.
- Stoop and Scoop - always clean up after your dog and use the dog waste stations.
- Dogs must be spayed or neutered.
- No more than two dogs per owner
- Fill in any hole your dog digs
- No smoking or human food in the off leash area
- Puppies under four (4) months of age are prohibited
- Dogs must be accompanied by a person 18 years or older
- Choke, prong, pinch and spike collars must be removed inside the park.
- No children under 12 years of age in the enclosure; children 12-17 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- No aggressive dogs or ill dogs may be brought into the park.
- No water feature allowed in the park
- If your dog becomes unruly, leave immediately.
- Public Safety enforces all City Code of Ordinances
- For emergencies phone 911 and non-emergencies 337-8120 (**Public Safety**).
